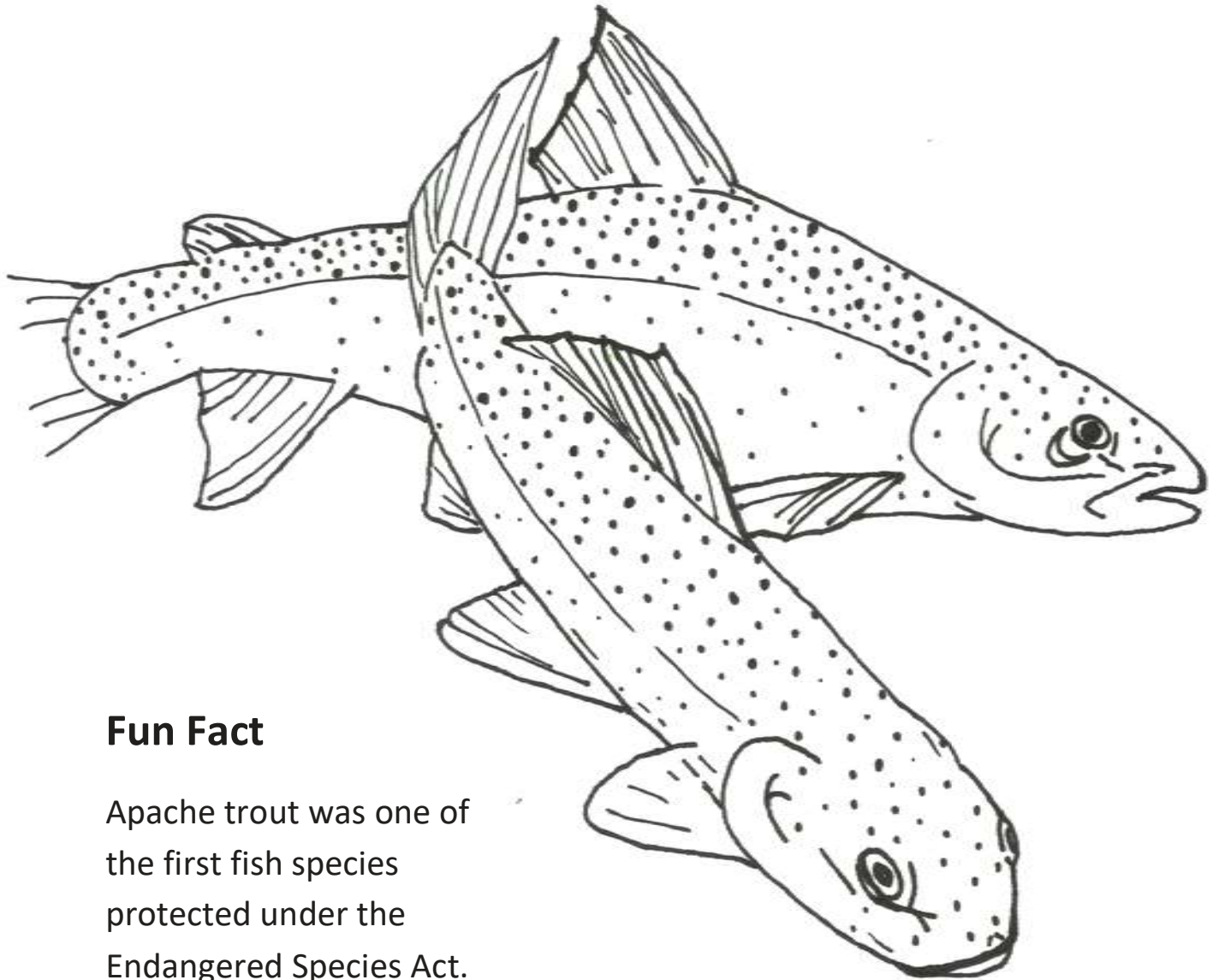


Apache Trout

One of only two native trout species in the state, Apache trout is the Arizona state fish. Identified by the olive-green and yellowish body, this fish inhabits the clear, cold waters in Arizona's White Mountains.
