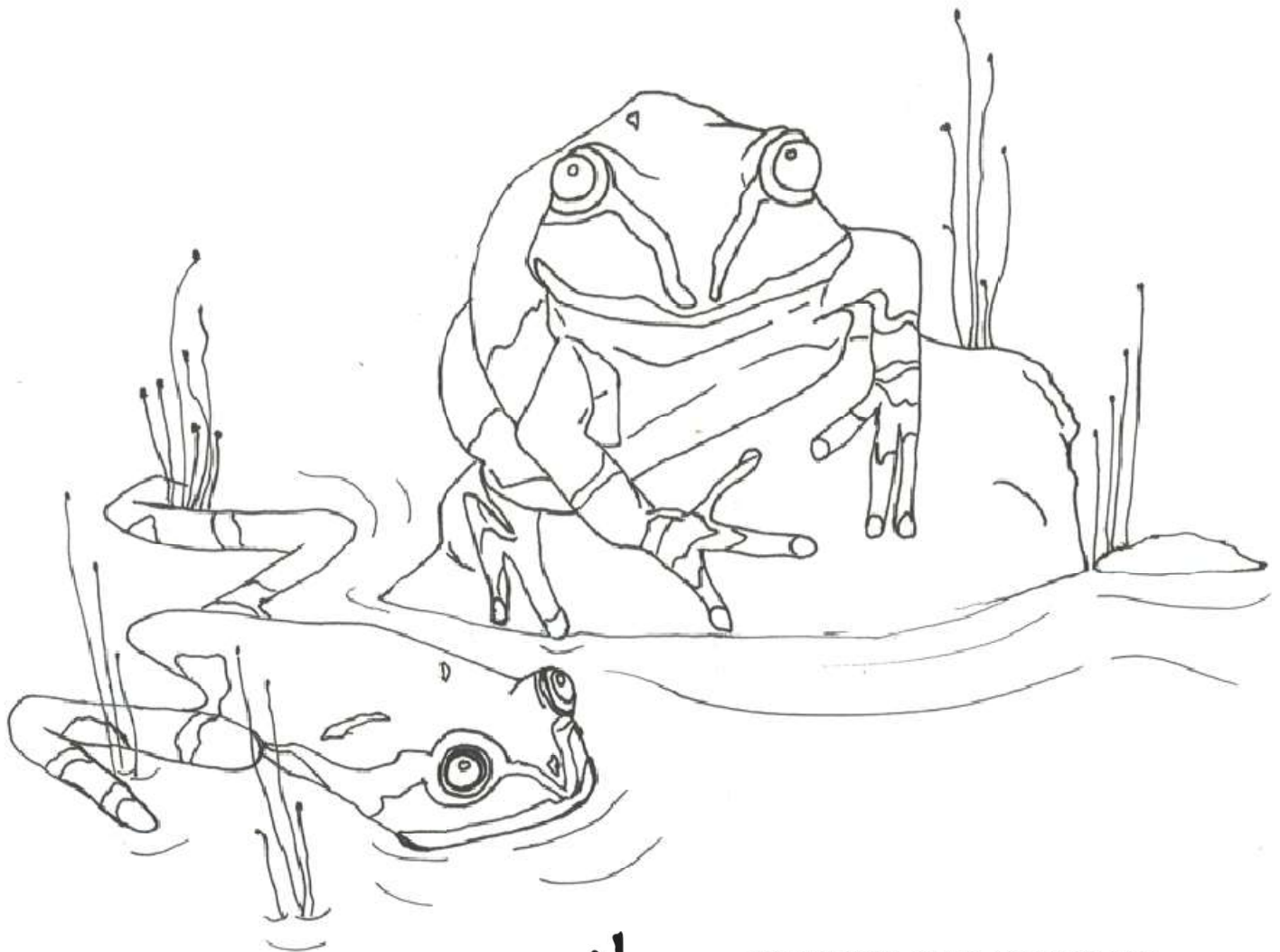


Arizona Tree Frog
